Background

The stock market learning is a business game organized by the savings banks since 1983.

Its aim is to bring students closer to the **systematic of** stock exchange.

By 2010 over 1 million teams had played.

With around 40,000 teams per year and a total of **140,000 participants**, the stock market simulation game has developed into one of the **worldwide largest stock market simulation game**.

This year, in 2020, a team from Vietnam will take part for the first time. A world premiere.

Gameplay




The students form teams with up to 4 members.

Each team gets access to the **online trading platform** and a virtual starting credit of **100,000 EUR** (approx. 2,700,000,000 VND).

The teams can buy and sell up to **200 securities** (stocks, fixed income securities / bonds, funds and certificates) on the trading platform.

The aim is to have the **depot with the highest value** at the end of the game. Next to their total value the depots **sustainability** will be rated, too.

Procedure

Prizes for students





	Highest total value	Best Sustainability
1. Team	12.000.000 VND	12.000.000 VND
2. Team	8.000.000 VND	8.000.000 VND
3. Team	4.000.000 VND	4.000.000 VND

Prerequisite: At least 3 teams consisting of VNU students must have registered so that the prize for the highest value will be paid out. At least 6 teams must have registered to activate the pay out for the sustainability competition.

The depots of all teams are automatically evaluated for both competitions. A victory in both competitions is possible; Thus, placements can be achieved in both categories.

Good to know I/III (in game)



Minimum number of orders and qualification time

At least three qualified orders that lead to a change in capital in the portfolio must be placed by the penultimate matchday on December 8th, 2020 at 11:00 am.

Upper limit and partial executions

A maximum of 20,000 EUR can be invested per security.

Holiday and ultimo settlement

The holiday regulations of the underlying stock exchanges apply (German holidays: 03/10/2020; 31/10/2020; 01/11/2020). Limit orders and stop orders without a term are valid until the next ultimo date at the latest.

Conditions of participation

All VNU students aged 16 and over can take part. It doesn't matter which faculty they belong to.

Teacher competition

If there is a need for a not awarded, separate teacher, this can be set up at short notice.

Determination of the winning teams

All depots are rated with the value of 09/12/2020 (11 a.m. German time = 5 pm Hanoi time). The evaluation and the associated determination of the winners is carried out by the Sparkassenstiftung.

Handover of the prizes

The prizes will be transferred to the winners by bank transfer. The account details will be requested by the Sparkasse after the winners have been determined.



...register and build a team?







1. The team leader

- registers himself / herself and creates a team. For this, he records the basic data of the depot (e.g. team name, university assignment and team size).
- invites the other members via email or WhatsApp.



2. The team members

- follow the invitation link and
- enter their own personal data and user ID in the corresponding form.



3. Every team member will receive an email with a link to confirm its registration.



4. As soon as the last participant has registered and confirmed the email, the team is fully setup.


...login at trading plattform?
